While our predominant focus in Quebec is its largest city, Montréal, it is impossible to ignore the call of the numerous cities in the province without an Apostolic church. In moving onsite, the Lord opened a door for us to oversee a work in Trois-Rivières, a city of 130,000 in the heart of Québec. We oversee one service three times a month and also are involved in leadership development.

The opportunity to practice our French language skills in a ministry setting and to experience the French culture firsthand has been an incredible blessing. We are miles ahead of where we would have been at this time without this experience. The congregation reflects the strong immigrant population of the province with worshippers from three or four countries in Africa, Chile and Columbia alongside the Québécois people.

This church has been the one French outpost that the UPCI has had outside Montréal in the eastern part of the province nearby its oldest city, named Québec City. It will serve as a launching point in time for church planting in the old city of 500,000 and in the region around it.

hold service was purchased with the assistance of the Home Missions Division many years ago, is fully paid for and sits on five acres of land.
